Are we ready for the next new idea at Elmley Castle?

Some of you may be aware that part of the government's plan to enhance PE in schools is to encourage better mental health and well-being though living an active, healthy lifestyle.

This week at Elmley Castle we have launched two new ideas that we would love you to support:

Daily Mile

In assembly we learnt about the national 'Daily Mile' campaign. We hope that all our school will take part in this activity at least twice a week. The aim is to walk, jog or run for ten minutes altogether. The children will be encouraged to better themselves each session but most importantly to enjoy the fresh air and comradery of taking part as a group. Statistics show that it has great educational benefits, improving concentration in the classroom too!

Elmley Explorers

The National Trust are running a scheme designed to encourage more outdoor exploration. '50 Things to do before you're 11³/₄' has a range of challenges that focus on adventure and being at one with nature.

We believe this could be a way of bringing together the many opportunities on offer at school and to be adventurous with those you enjoy as a family. Each half term we will give you an outdoor focus and we'd love this to become a regular part of our homework routine. We ask that you talk with your children about what they could do or have done and maybe take a picture or write a few words about it. We hope to display these exciting adventures on our whole school display - come and have a look! The first task is attached to this newsletter. Please have fun with it and share your experiences with us.
